

Oasis Academy Arena Admission Arrangements for 2022/23

Introductory Statement

Oasis Academy Arena is an academy where all their young people are given the opportunity they deserve to make excellent progress and fulfil their full potential. Oasis Academy Arena is a fully inclusive secondary academy, accepting children of all abilities, of any faith or none.

Admission Numbers

The school has an admission number of 180 for entry in year 7

The school will accordingly admit this number of students if there are sufficient applications. Where fewer applicants than the published admission number(s) for the relevant year group are received, the Academy Trust will offer places at the school to all those who have applied.

Application Process

All spaces for admission to Year 7 at Oasis Academy Arena are allocated via the Pan London Coordinated Process. This means that, wherever you reside in London, you may list a school in any London borough on just one form (the Common Application Form). If you wish to apply for a place at Oasis Academy Arena, you must complete the Common Application Form (CAF), online from your home local authority. There is no supplementary information form.

For Croydon residents, information regarding all secondary schools in the borough is available on the <u>Croydon Council website</u>. This site also provides you with a step by step guide regarding the application process. We have also provided a range of information to support you here.

The process of allocating places will begin after 31 October 2022 you will be sent an email from London Borough Croydon on 1 March 2023

Oversubscriptions and Tie Break

When the school is oversubscribed, after the admission of students with an Education, Health and Care Plan naming the school, priority for admission will be given to those children who meet the criteria set out below, in priority order:

- Looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangements order, or special guardianship order.
- 2. Children whose sibling(s) currently attend the school and who will continue

- 3. Children for whom a particular school is appropriate on genuine medical grounds.
- 4. Distance: priority will be given to Children living closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school

Late Applications

All applications received by London Borough Croydon after the deadline will be considered to be late applications. Late applications will be considered after those received on time.

If, following consideration of all applicants the school is oversubscribed, parents may request that their child is placed on the school's waiting list.

Admission of children outside their normal age group

Parents may request that their child is admitted outside their normal age group. To do so parents should include a request with their application, specifying why admission out of normal year group is being requested, and the year group in which they wish their child to be allocated a place.

When such a request is made, the academy trust will make a decision on the basis of the circumstances of the case and in the best interests of the child concerned, taking into account the views of the Principal and any supporting evidence provided by the parent. Appeals
