Dear Parents & Carers of Year 10 students,

I am writing to inform you that I have made the decision to temporarily move Year 10 students to home learning from tomorrow morning (Tuesday 17th November) until Monday 23rd November. Students are expected to return on Monday, however, if the situation changes I will be in touch prior to the weekend.

We have a significant number of staff out of school currently and due to low numbers of teachers I have had to make this decision. I have not taken this decision lightly.

Please note that we are only asking your child to learn from home because we do not currently have enough staff to have them at the Academy. They are not being asked to self-isolate.

The school remains open students in other year groups and they can continue to attend school as normal.

I know that asking Year 10 to learn from home for the next few days may significantly inconvenience you; please rest assured that we will continue to do everything that we can to continue your child's education as normally as possible. We will be teaching lessons via Microsoft Teams. Your child should log into MS Teams from 8.50am and they can click on the lesson in the calendars where they will be able to watch the lesson as normal.

If for any reason your child is not able to log into MS Teams, they should email my PA, Mrs Nunn, on lynn.nunn@oasisarena.org and she will reset their password and support them. I have included with this letter a copy of the information that you were sent in the summer to support the use of MS Teams.
